Course instructions

Attending lectures and seminars is highly recommended. You must be personally present to defend your seminar paper. Learning and teaching methods will be:

- Lectures with active participation of students (explanations, discussion, cases, problem-solving);
- Seminar work (discussions project work, team work, method of critical thinking);
- Use of online classroom or other contemporary ICT tools;
- Individual research work.

Assesement:

- Type (examination, oral, coursework, project):
- Essay in the form of scientific article of 5000 words at least. The grading scale is harmonized with the Rules for verification and evaluation of knowledge.

To pass the course the student needs to meet minimum criteria set by the grading regulations of the FUDŠ/SASS for the production of written products (published on www.fuds.si under the section "pravilniki in obrazci").
