OBLIGATIONS IN THE SUBJECT »EUROPEAN INTEGRATION«

Attending lectures and seminars is highly recommended. You must be personally present to defend your seminar paper.

- Written exam (50% of grade)
- 3 regular exam deadlines (two deadlines in June, 1 deadline in August/September)
- Participation and performance of obligations in lectures and exercises (50% of the grade)
- 3 meetings - exercises, 2 meetings - lectures
- Preparation of a seminar paper (35% of the grade and its oral presentation - 15%

Exam:

- Written exam - 50% (4-5 essay questions)
- Manner of submitting seminar papers:

FUDŠ - Moodle (submission via e-mail is not considered a completed obligation).

* more detailed obligations will be presented in lectures and tutorials

To pass the course the student needs to meet minimum criteria set by the grading regulations of the FUDŠ/SASS for the production of written products (published on www.fuds.si under the section "pravilniki in obrazci"). However, to pass student needs to meet the minimum criteria for both seminar paper and exam.

The points from seminar paper and individual assessments are valid until the beginning of the new academic year.
